At a recent "Special Steering Committee Meeting" on Monday Jan. 3, 2022 the topics of discussion were the Saturday Morning Sunrise Meeting and whether to continue to meet in person as a hybrid meeting or temporarily meet on ZOOM only.

It was decided that due to the scheduled speaker being unable to attend the live gathering, and the replacement speaker coming to us from Boston, that the **Saturday, January 8, meeting would be a Zoom only meeting**.

In the interest of continuing our live/Zoom hybrid format it was further decided that beginning on Saturday, January 15, going forward until deemed necessary, the live portion of the meeting would be subject to the following guidelines:

- All fellowship prior to, and after, the meeting will need to be conducted outside
- Masks are mandatory indoors (covering mouth and nose)
- No food or beverages will be provided we encourage you to bring your own
- Observe social distancing while indoors includes seating during the meeting
- We will be standing in place for the "Lord's Prayer" No group gathering / circle

The word "mandatory" was something we struggled with; however, there is no way around it. Hopefully, we will be able to go back to using "optional" very soon.

We would very much like to see all our Alcoholics Anonymous members, and those struggling, in person but if you are not comfortable with these guidelines we certainly understand. We encourage you to join us on ZOOM until we can all come back together safely.

We appreciate your understanding as we strive to bring you the safest in-person meeting possible.
