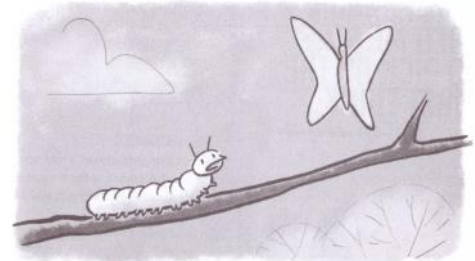
BITE-SIZED
