In the interest of continuing our live/Zoom hybrid format it was decided that beginning on Saturday, January 15, going forward until deemed necessary, the live portion of the meeting would be subject to the following guidelines:

- All fellowship prior to, and after, the meeting will need to be conducted outside
- Masks are mandatory indoors (covering mouth and nose)
- No food or beverages will be provided - we encourage you to bring your own
- Observe social distancing while indoors - includes seating during the meeting
- We will be standing in place for the "Lord's Prayer" - No group gathering / circle
